There are no test dates available for the Fall 2020 semester. College Level Examination (CLEP). Offered by the College Entrance Examination Board, OU is a CLEP testing center. The University does not award credit for what were formerly the CLEP general examinations (English Composition, Humanities, Natural Sciences, Social Sciences, and History).
