Guggenheim Museum, *The Third Mind* traces how the classical arts of India, China, and Japan influenced American artists. *The Third Mind: American Artists Contemplate Asia, 1860-1989* illuminates the dynamic and complex impact of Asian art, literary texts and philosophical concepts on American artistic practices from the late nineteenth century through the present. *The Third Mind* is a wonderful exploration of Asian influence on American artists. It touched on several areas I had not considered. It was a good read to prepare for viewing the exhibition. This massive and thoroughly researched collected volume covers the Asian influence on American art from the late 19th century to the present. The articles are serious and interesting and are profusely illustrated in b & w and color as well. I especially enjoyed the article on Abstract Expressionism, as it showed links between Japanese and Chinese art and the classics of Abstract Expressionism that have been repressed and denied, partly for political reasons. As Samsung Senior Curator of Asian Art at the Solomon R. Guggenheim Museum, Munroe spearheads the museum's Asian Art Initiative, expanding the institution's mission to study, acquire, and exhibit art from beyond the Western world.[15] In this role, she guides the Solomon R. Guggenheim Foundation's exhibitions, acquisitions, and public programs relating to Asian art for its museums worldwide.
